Disruption to Lessons

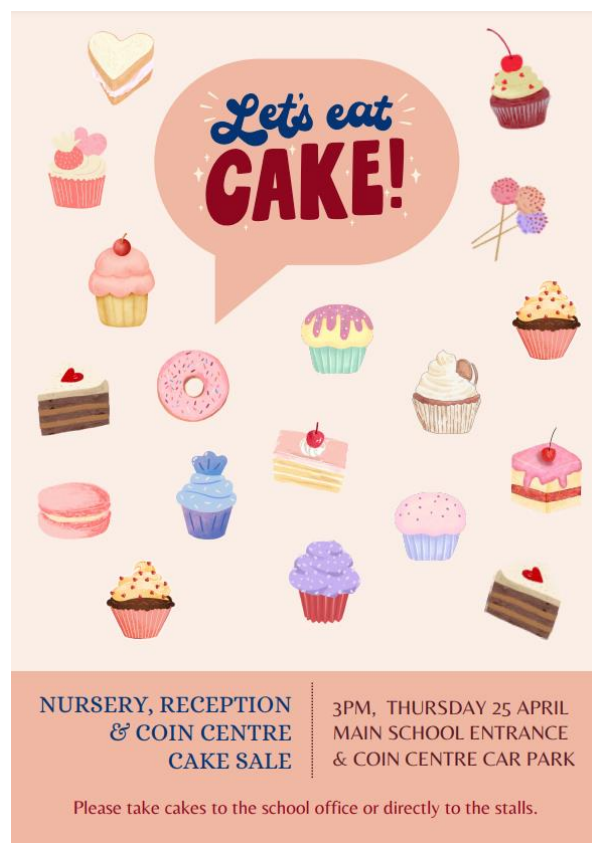
