1. News and messages

A Fantastic Day at District Sports for Chandlers Field

On Thursday 27th June we took a squad of 32 children from Year 3-6 to take part in the Esher District Sports at the Xcel sports hub against 12 other schools. It was the first time in 2 years it has taken place so for most of our team it was a brand-new experience to be competing against other schools in front of a noisy crowd. Our team certainly didn't let it phase them and showed great togetherness, courage and perseverance to compete against lots of strong athletes from all the other schools.

They participated in a range of track and field events from the 60m sprint to the 600m. All the children represented our school brilliantly, not only in their events but also their behaviour was faultless. There were some outstanding individual performances from a number of children. In Year 3 Louis came 2nd in his 60m sprint heat to reach the final and came an amazing 3rd place to win the bronze medal. His success fed into the Year 3 boys relay where he, Salih, Harrison and Sammy stormed the race to take the gold. After his relay efforts, Sammy then turned his attention to the 300m where he led from start to finish to take his second gold medal of the day. Eva also competed brilliantly in the 300m and came a great 5th place in the girl's race. In Year 4, Kymia ran a great 300m to just be beaten on the line to the bronze medal and came an amazing 4th. Elsa in Year 5 ran in a very competitive 600m and her and another girl pushed each other all the way to

the finish way ahead of 3rd and won an incredible silver medal. Thank you to all the adults who came along to support them, we could hear your cheers from the other side of the track. Well done to all the children who took part. They really did try their absolute best in everything they did and we can certainly be very proud of them!
