## E-safety

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The internet is a wonderful resource. At Chandlers Field E-safety is embedded across the curriculum and is also part of our PSHE curriculum. We all need to ensure that we support children on how to use the internet, remain safe in the virtual world and become a positive digital citizen. Within the curriculum we discuss with the children the three key areas of safety:

- ◆ content: what to do when exposed to inappropriate online material



- ◆ contact: how to stay safe online if interacting with other users
- ◆ conduct: how to manage your own personal online behaviour

These are discussed at an age appropriate level. There are excellent resources available to parents and the links to these can be found on our website in the parents area. A good first site to visit is the NSPCC, where they discuss their T.E.A.M. approach to online safety for parents in supporting their children.

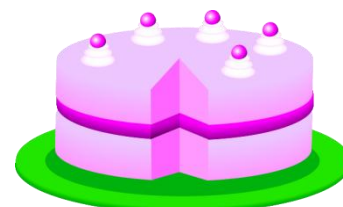
