Chickenpox

This is just to make you aware that we currently have several cases of chickenpox at school.

Children are infectious from 1-2 days prior to the start of the rash and continue to be so until all spots are crusted (usually about 5 days). Children should therefore be kept away from school or nursery until 5 days after the onset of the rash.



Pencil Cases!

Pencil cases, of a manageable size, are lovely to help keep the children's stationary together and it's lovely seeing the children looking after their belongings. However there appears to be some extremely well fed pencil cases appearing in school which are so big they are a problem getting them from school bag to desks. 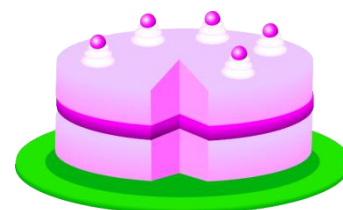
