**R**eports - At Chandlers Field every child has, in the past, received an end of year school report which informs parents and carers about their child’s progress, attainment, attendance and a brief comment on their child’s main strengths and areas for development.

As a school we are always looking at ways to keep parents and carers as informed as possible about their child. With this in mind, we have been discussing whether one report at the end of the academic year was the best way to keep you up to date with your child’s performance academically.

For children in Reception through to Year 6, we are going to replace the traditional end of year school report with a one sheet, termly report (3 per year) that will be given out at open evenings giving you the opportunity to discuss it with your child and their class teacher.

The first Parent and Carer Consultation Evenings are on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of November. More information about signing up for an appointment will be communicated the first week back after half term.

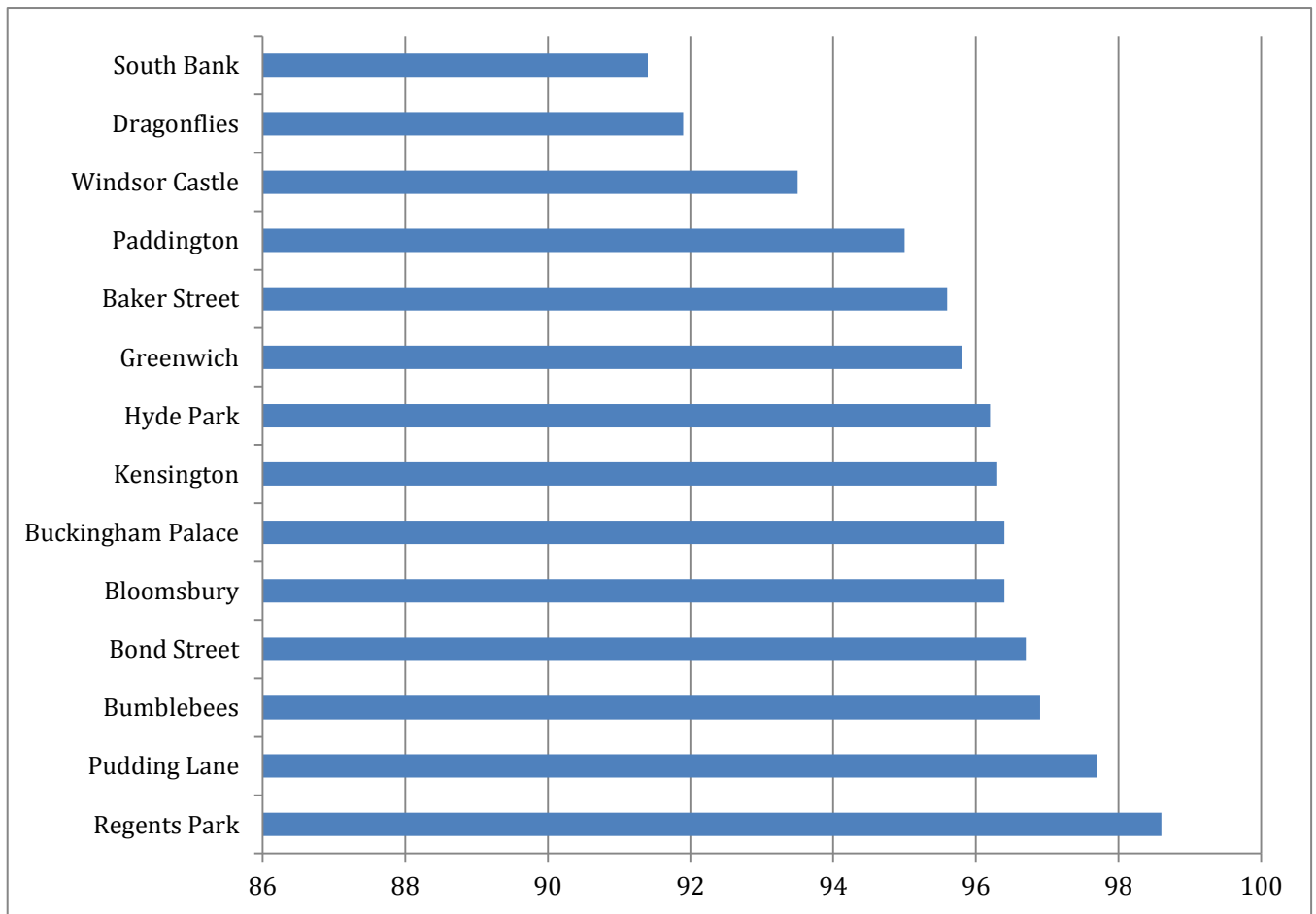
