Parents Evening takes place next week. If you need another copy of the letter, please speak to either your class teacher or the school office urgently.

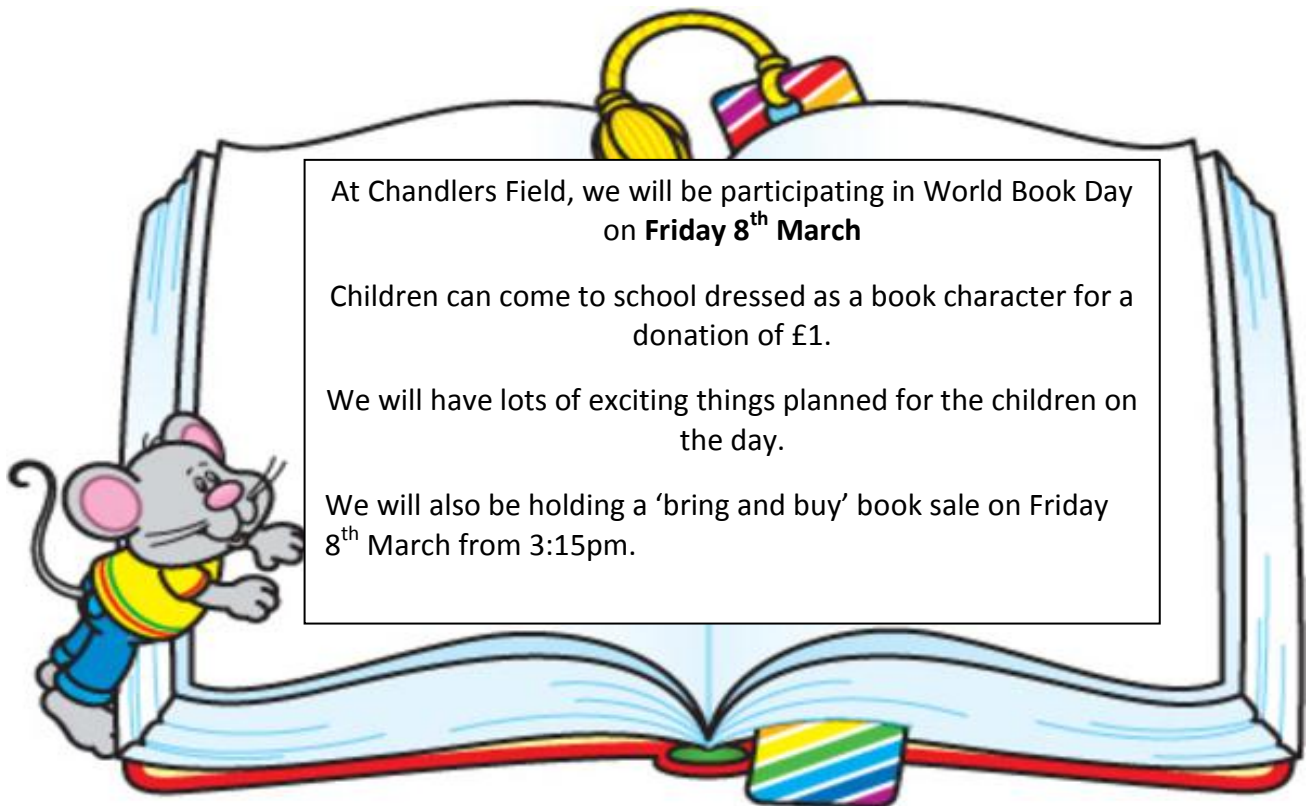
Friends of CFPS – Exciting news
