| 6. | $2^{\text {nd }}$ April: Easter Raffle <br> Could we all start getting/ collecting donations from local shops/ businesses? We need to produce a poster and get it up asap. | 7. | Purchasing <br> It was previously agreed that we would fund the purchase of $3 x$ picnic tables for the reception playgrounds. After consultation with the school we have found suitable, hardwearing and sturdy tables at cost of $£ 259.95$ each. Total cost to be funded by FOCFS is $£ 779.85$. <br> We also agreed to purchase the popcorn machine that Tina had borrowed for the movie night, at cost of $£ 40$. | 8. | AOB <br> - Why don't we have lunchtime club such as 'Penguins' - quite a few of our children need it. Also is there a 'quiet room' for children who need it? (suggest this is raised with the school directly) <br> - Sunshade/ Sail for the playgrounds: still awaiting costs from school <br> - Tesco Coins (fundraising): TL looked into this but the scheme has closed to new applicants as they were overwhelmed with requests <br> - Funding/ bids for larger amounts: One of the schemes opens in February, we should be bidding for funding, perhaps for the sunshades? (JE, GP). Ideally we need a member of the FOCFS to take a lead on this, supported by a member of staff at the school. JE? <br> - PE uniform for district sports/ football team kits etc: It was pointed out that the school's image could be better at events, if everyone had matching kit. Could the FOCFS purchase some kit? Again, we need someone to take a lead on this and liaise with PE teacher/ dept at school... <br> - We need more benches for the children to sit on in the playgrounds, not just in reception, could this be something that we fundraise for? | Please get in touch if you think you could offer some help in these areas <br> Funding/ bids <br> District sports/ football team kits <br> Benches <br> Decide whether or not to do the quiz night <br> (TL/SS/SA) |
