Pupil Absence Procedures

The School's Attendance Policy states that parents and carers must inform the school office on the first day their child is absent from school and on any subsequent days.

Absence calls to school must be made by 9.00am. If you call the previous evening please leave a message on school voicemail. After 8.30am please leave a message on the absence line by choosing option 1. This procedure is to ensure that your child is safeguarded at all times.

If a child has not arrived at school and we have not heard from a parent or carer we have to follow up to find out where they are; they may have gone missing on the way to school, you may be ill and be unable to raise help.

If we have not heard why your child is absent, we will try to call you and if we cannot make contact with you we will call the people on the list of contacts you have provided.

If we are unable to make contact with a parent, carer or designated relative over the phone and we do not know where your child is we will do a home visit to make sure they, and you are safe. As a final step, we will call the police.

It is important that the list of emergency contacts is always up to date. If you need to provide the office with any changes to these, please could you do so as soon as possible.

Leave of absence taken during term time will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. You may be liable to receive a Penalty Notice for unauthorised leave of absence taken during term

time. Please refer to the school's Attendance Policy available on our website, for more details.

Year 3 – 6 Packed Lunches and School Dinners

If your child wishes to change from pack lunch to school dinners or vice versa you need to inform the office, giving a minimum of one weeks' notice of this change. Children must have school dinners or packed lunch for a whole week and cannot change from day to day.

This follows Surrey County Council guidelines and allows our catering staff to have enough food for pupils while, at the same time, not wasting food.

Social Distancing

When dropping off or picking up your child please remember to socially distance at all times and do not stay on the school site any longer than is necessary. Could you please also observe social distancing if you arrive early and the school gate has not yet opened. Thank you for your co-operation.

Parking Considerately

Please be considerate when parking in the local roads surrounding the school. Please leave enough space so that our neighbours can use their driveways, cars can get down the road and our children can cross safely.



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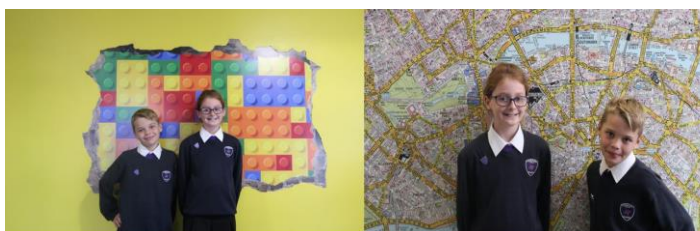

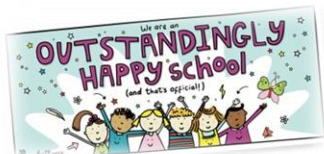

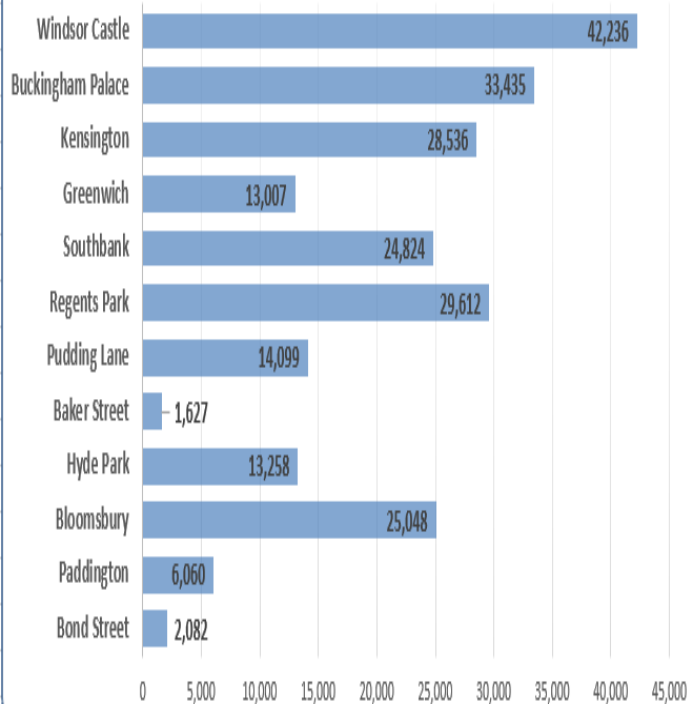


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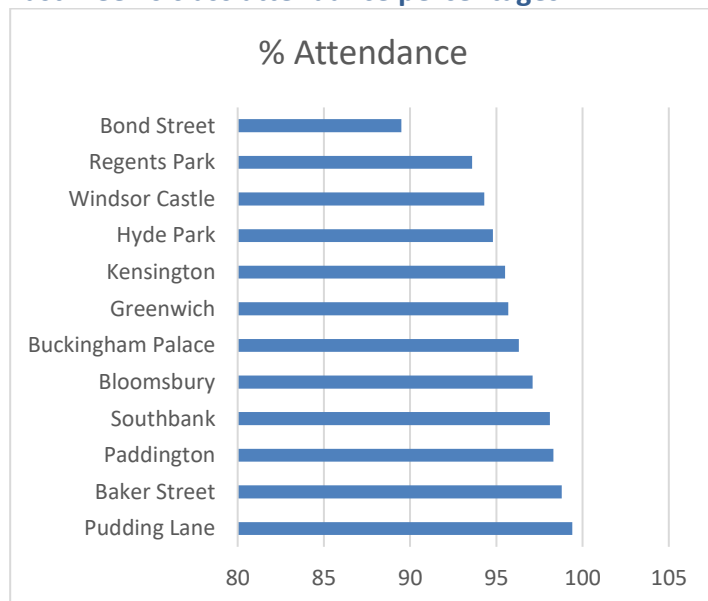
MATHEMATICS PARTICIPATION POINTS ACADEMIC YEAR TO DATE 28/9/20
