This new lockdown has understandably heightened concerns over the risk of spreading the Coronavirus so we have been trying to think of safe ways of having some normal events and festivities for the children.

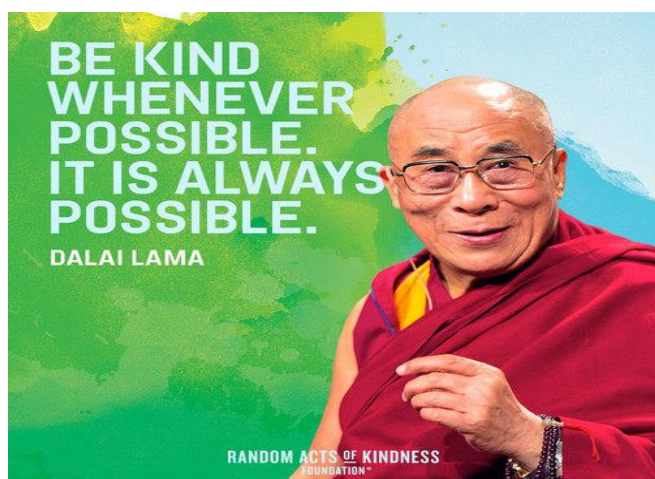
## Children in Need

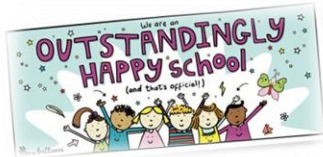
## Children's work sent home

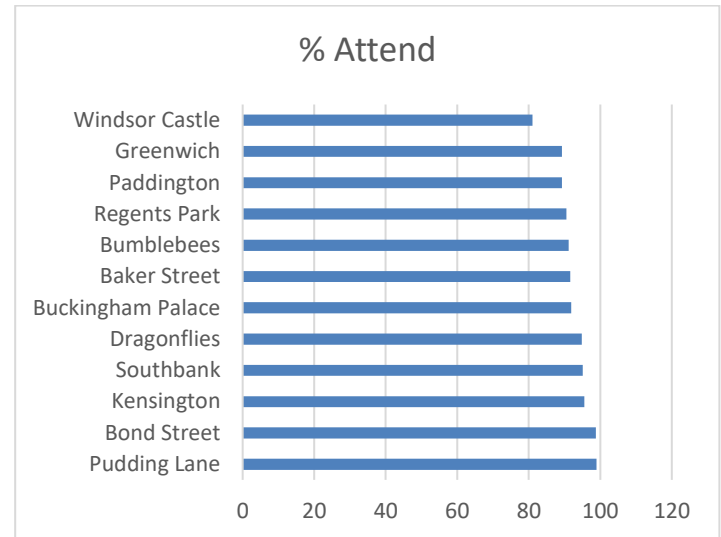
