Thank you for your ongoing support and for so generously donating towards the events we held recently at a time when many are finding it hard financially. It is so kind that you think of others who are also struggling.

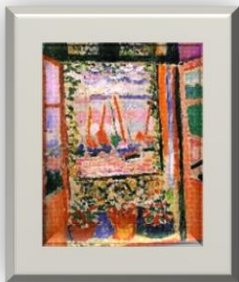
Red nose day It was great to see so many children wearing their brightest clothes (and smiles!) on Red Nose Day. Thank you to all who donated. We raised £293.78.

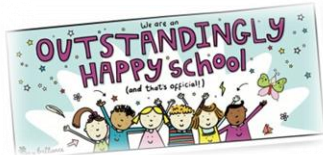


New Headteachers Award Badges

Thank you to those of you who park considerately every day.

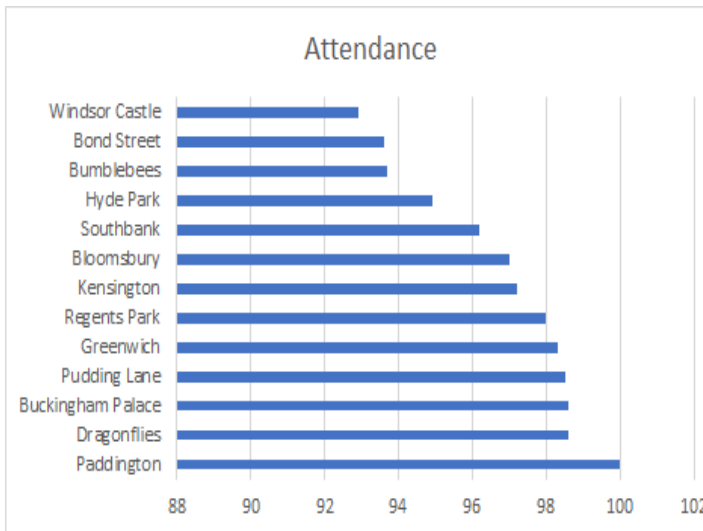

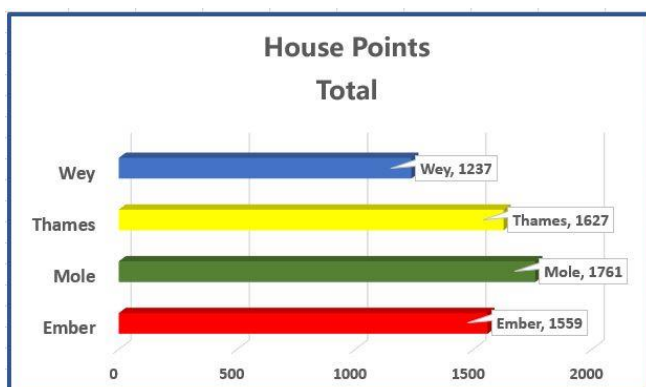
