Can parents please be aware that they must not park on the yellow zigzag lines near the school or the double yellow lines beyond these. If parking further from the school, please leave the pavement clear to allow all pedestrians to pass your car. We are aware that sometimes parents park such that those in wheelchairs or with visual impairment cannot pass - please consider their needs carefully. - Please avoid parking across our neighbours' driveways blocking their access.

A parent has also been in contact with the police and the Highways department regarding their concerns over the lack of consideration some drivers are showing when parking their vehicle. We have been told that they will be patrolling the area.

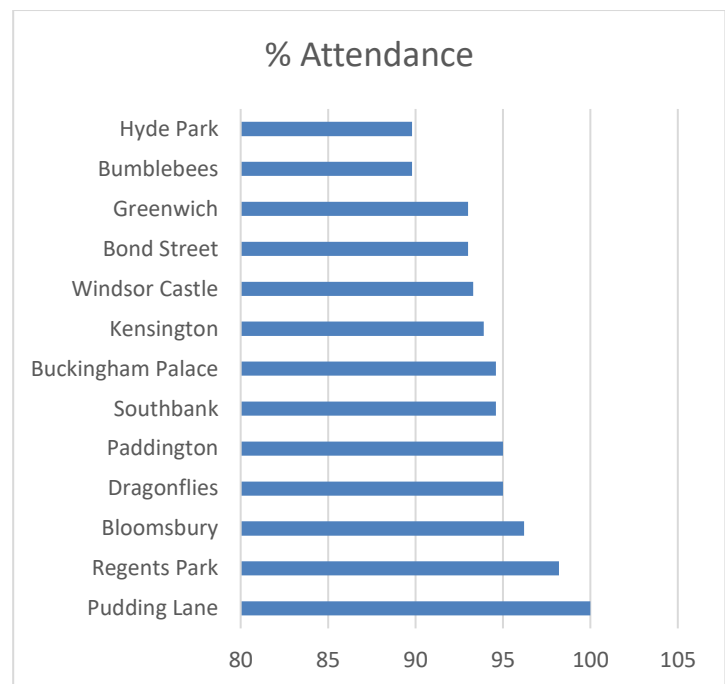
