Pupil Absence Procedures

The School's Attendance Policy states that parents and carers must inform the school office on the first day their child is absent from school and on any subsequent days.

Absence calls to school must be made by 9.00am. If you call the previous evening please leave a message on school voicemail. After 8.30 am please leave a message on the absence line by choosing option 1. This procedure is to ensure that your child is safeguarded at all times.

If a child has not arrived at school and we have not heard from a parent or carer we have to follow up to find out where they are; they may have gone missing on the way to school, you may be ill and be unable to raise help.

If we have not heard why your child is absent, we will try to call you and if we cannot make contact with you we will call the people on the list of contacts you have provided.

If we are unable to make contact with a parent, carer or designated relative over the phone and we do not know where your child is we will do a home visit to make sure they, and you are safe. As a final step, we will call the police.

It is important that the list of emergency contacts is always up to date. If you need to provide the office with any changes to these, please could you do so as soon as possible.

Leave of absence taken during term time will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances. You may be liable to receive a Penalty Notice for unauthorised leave of absence taken during term time. Please refer to the school's Attendance Policy available on our website, for more details.

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority, they will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently

the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court.

Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices.

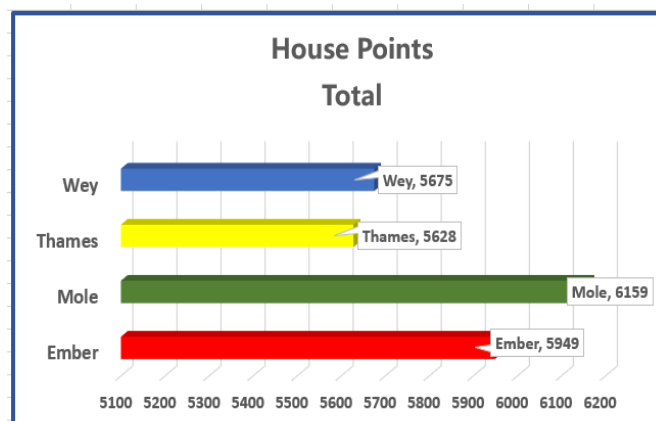

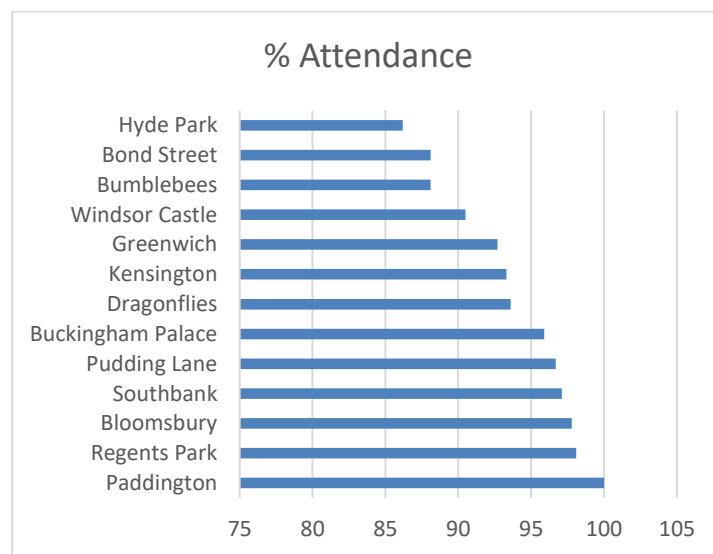
