Agenda

1. Launch of basketball club
 - Ziya updated the school council on the successful launch of lunchtime basketball club
 - Years 3,4,6 clubs have started. Year 5 did not want a club at present
 - In summer term they will re-launch the club for Years 1 and 2
2. Items raised in the post-boxes
 - Year 5 asked if they can play football outside the Wembley ball zone. Unanimous agreement that playing on the tarmac may not be safe for other children but playing on the field is a good idea. Councillors fed back that the children currently play on the football field anyway.
 - Year 3 asked for a nature club. The councillors felt there is a nature club at lunchtimes run by the forest school teacher. Year 3 councillor and chair will follow up with Miss Lammert on the timetable for summer term.
 - Year 6 request for more comfy seats and even beds in class. Council felt beds not needed and that chairs are comfortable enough. They discussed cost of padded chairs in classes and felt money would be better spent on other areas in school.
3. School council presence across the school (public relations)
 - Information posters will be created next term to communicate the role of school councillors
4. Class feedback on assembly ideas for key stage assemblies
 - Councillors will ask their classes what areas of interest they would like to discuss in future assemblies – and if any children would like to take part in delivering assemblies
