Sports Day

Last Thursday, finally saw our sports day for Years 1-6 happen and despite an early shower just before the Year 1 and 2 session the weather was perfect this time round. All the children competed in a variety of different events for their house teams from an obstacle course relay to a spacer hopper race and the more traditional sprints and relays races. Lots of skill, determination and perseverance was displayed in all races, especially the long distances of the 300m and 600m races. The day was split into 3 sessions with Year 1 and 2 going first with lots of very close races that ended with Mole (green) winning. Year 5 and 6 competed next with Thames (yellow) being triumphant and the day ended with Ember (red) winning the Year 3 and 4 competition.

This left the result of Reception's sports day on Friday to decide who would be our overall winner. It was great seeing our youngest athletes compete in a sports day for the first time and eventually Thames (yellow) won. With this result the final overall standings were: 4th Wey (blue) with 319 points, 3rd Ember (red) with 375 points, 2nd Mole (green) with 415 meaning 1st place and winners of the Chandlers Field sports day 2022 were Thames (yellow) with 444 points.

Special thanks need to go to our amazing Year 6 helpers who aided in the event running so smoothly and Mrs Edwards who kept a close eye on the scores all day. Well done to Thames and all the children on what was a fantastic sports day where the children all tried their best and had fun. 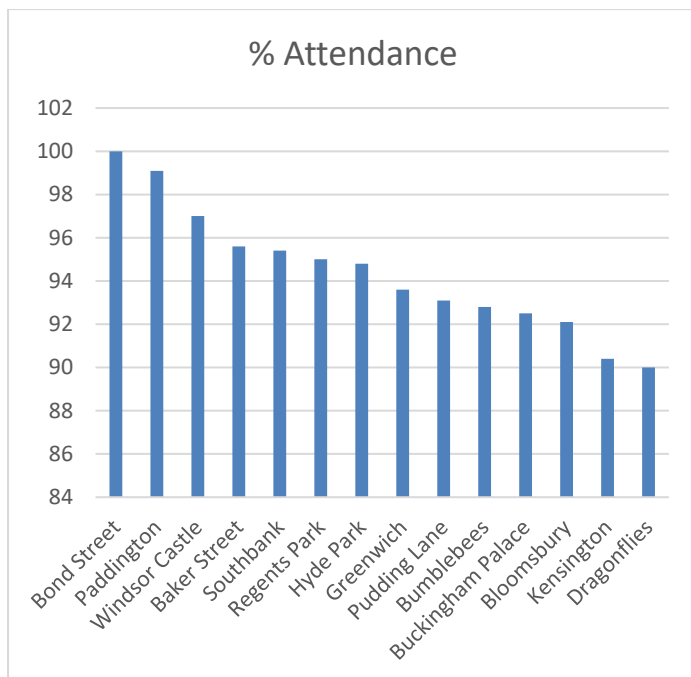
