District Sports

On Thursday 30 June we took a squad of 21 children from Year 3-6 to take part in the Esher District Sports at the Xcel sports hub against 12 other schools. It was the first time in 3 years it has taken place so for most of our team it was a brand new experience to be competing against other schools in front of a noisy crowd. Our team certainly didn't let it phase them and showed great togetherness, courage and perseverance to compete against lots of strong athletes from all the



other schools. They participated in a range of track and field events from the 80m sprint to the 600m for some and even the high jump. All the children represented our school brilliantly, not only in their events but also their behaviour was faultless. There were some outstanding individual performances from a number of children. In Year 3 Bobby came 4th in his 80m sprint heat to reach the semi-final. Olly, Woody and Emily from Year 4 all made the semi-finals in the 80m sprint also with Olly making it through to the final where he came an amazing 5th. Dolly in Year 5 showed huge amounts of courage and ability to not only win the bronze medal in the high jump but also in the 600m as well with a fantastic run. In Year 6, Louis's competitive spirit coupled with great skill meant he was involved in an epic high jump competition where he and another boy ended up having to share the gold medal after each of them managed a huge 1.35m jump. Thank you to all the adults who came along to support them, we could hear your cheers from the other side of the track. Well done to all the children who



took part. They really did try their absolute best in everything they did and we can certainly be very proud of them!


