30 Hour Nursery Code

If your child is currently attending the nursery for 30 hours, please may we remind you to reconfirm your 30 hour code before the end of term. If codes are not reconfirmed every term your child may fall out of eligibility for extended provision. If you are having problems reconfirming your code please contact the Childcare Choices helpline number on 0300 123 4097 as soon as possible.

Starting school for the first time – September 2023

If your child was born between 1 September 2018 & 31 August 2019 you should be applying for a primary school place. All applications have to be made online, please log on to: www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions. If you need another copy of the leaflet or need any help please call the school office and ask to speak to Mrs Gill.

Please note that having a child in our nursery does not guarantee that you will automatically be offered a place at Chandlers Field School. Admission to Reception is subject to a separate application being made.

You will need to apply for a school place by **15 January 2023**.

Nursery Stay and Play session

We would like to invite you to our 'Stay and Play' session in our Nursery. The session will take place on Wednesday 30th November. The times will be: 8.45-9.00am for AM and All Day children, 12.30-12.45PM for PM children. In this session you will have the opportunity to spend some time with your child in the Nursery classroom and engage in a variety of learning activities.
