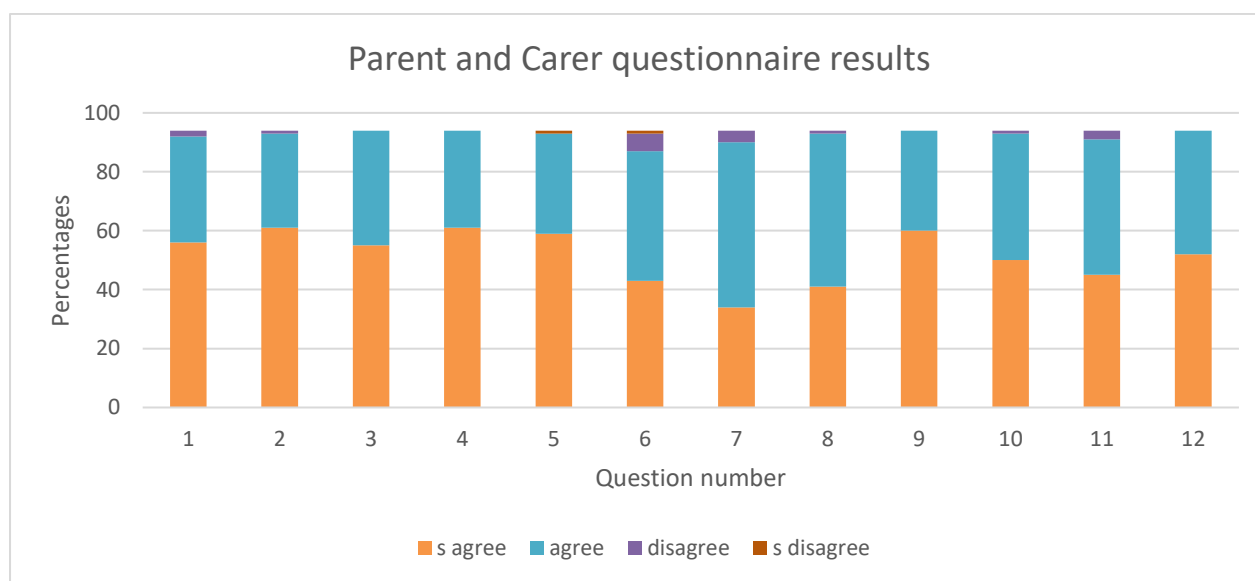

Starting school for the first time – September 2023

If your child was born between 1 September 2018 & 31 August 2019 you should be applying for a primary school place. All applications have to be made online, please log on to: www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions. If you need another copy of the leaflet or need any help please call the school office and ask to speak to Mrs Gill.

Please note that having a child in our nursery does not guarantee that you will automatically be offered a place at Chandlers Field School. Admission to Reception is subject to a separate application being made.

You will need to apply for a school place by **15 January 2023**.

Code of Conduct on the School Site

Could we please remind you that all children, parents, visitors and staff have a right to feel safe. We expect all adults (and older siblings) in school to behave well at all times.

There are also signs displayed around school following Surrey Guidelines as follows:-

We welcome visitors to our school.

We will act to ensure it remains a safe place for pupils, staff and all other members of our community.

If you have concerns we will always listen to them and seek to address them.

Please be aware, however, that abusive, threatening or violent behaviour will not be tolerated in this school.

Visitors behaving in this way are likely to be removed from the premises and prosecuted”.

If the above is not adhered to it may result in the withdrawal of permission to enter the school premises.

Drop off and pick up times.

We all know that children like to play and I certainly do not want to discourage that as so much learning happens through play.

However, (there is always a however!) the children need to be aware of when it is the right time to play.

With parents and young children at the front of the school at the start and end of the day there have been a number of near miss accidents that could have been serious.

I am asking you to

- Keep your children with you
- Ensure scooters and bikes are not ridden until your child has left the school site
- Ensure that chasing games and footballs are not played with or kicked at drop off and pick up times
- Please, Please, Please! Keep your child out of the car park – it is dangerous and drivers are looking for a place to park.

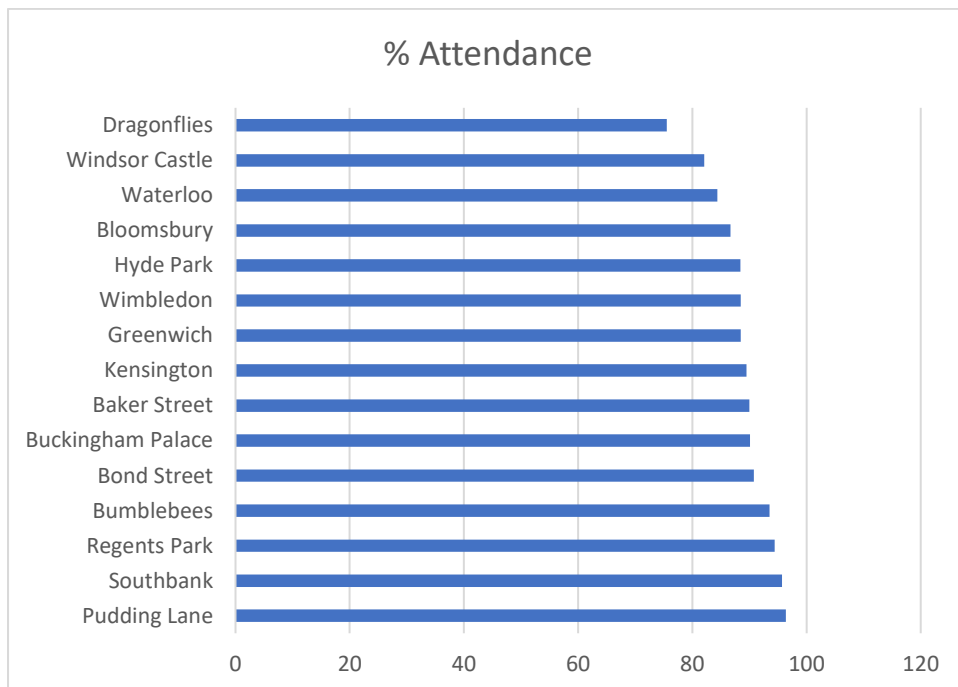
