Safer Internet Day

On **Tuesday 7th February** we will be joining schools and youth organisations across the UK in celebrating **Safer Internet Day 2023**. Safer Internet Day is a global campaign to promote the safe and responsible use of technology.

Using the internet safely and positively is a key message that we continually promote. Celebrating Safer Internet Day is a great opportunity for us to re-emphasise the online safety messages we deliver throughout the year. Some of the activities we'll be participating in on the day include: class assemblies on online safety, discussing what information should be shared online, creating a safe gaming guide and watching internet safety films including Digiduck! There will be lots of discussion throughout the day.

Parking

Parking remains an issue around school. As a key part of the local community, we are very conscious that everyone should respect our neighbours and local residents in conjunction with placing huge importance on the safety of our children.

We therefore have strict parking requirements which we would ask you to observe at the beginning and end of the day.

Can all parents and carers please be aware that they **must not park on the yellow zigzag lines near the school or the double yellow lines** beyond these.

We recommend that you consider parking further from the school and walking a few steps further to ease congestion.

Please leave the pavement clear to allow all pedestrians space to pass your car.

Please do not parking across our neighbours' driveways blocking their access.

With a bit of respect and thought for both the safety of our school community along with the inconvenience caused to local residents, drop off and pick up will be a much safer calmer time.

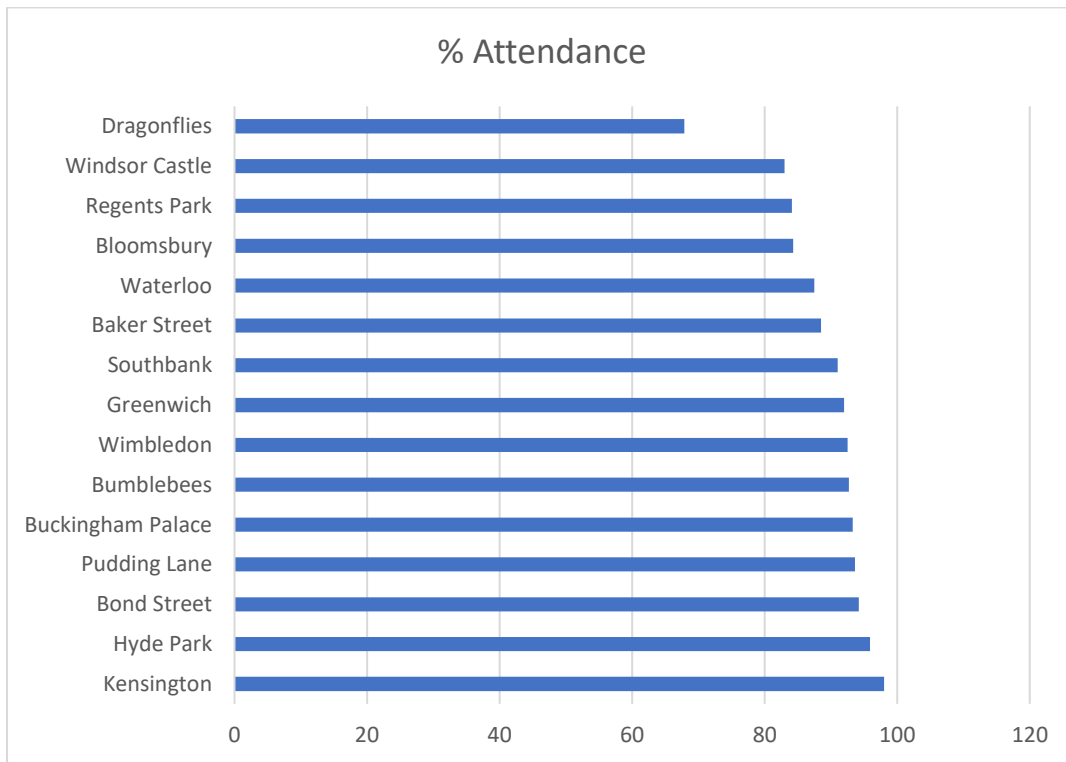
