### Sports Day

Last Friday, saw our sports day for Years 1-6 happen. All the children competed in a variety of different events for their house teams from an obstacle course relay to a spacer hopper race and the more traditional sprints and relays races. Lots of skill, determination and perseverance was displayed in all races, especially the long distances of the 300m and 600m races. The day was split into 3 sessions with Year 1 and 2 going first with lots of very close races that ended with Thames (yellow) winning. Year 5 and 6 competed next with Thames (yellow) being triumphant and the day ended with Mole (green) winning the Year 3 and 4 competition. This result meant the final overall standings were: 4<sup>th</sup> Ember (red) with 228 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> Wey (blue) with 262 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> Mole (green) with 313 meaning 1<sup>st</sup> place and winners of the Chandlers Field sports day 2023 were Thames (yellow) with 372 points.

Special thanks need to go to our amazing Year 6 helpers who aided in the event running so smoothly alongside Mrs Edwards, Mrs Starkey and Mr Luxon. Well done to Thames and all the children on what was a fantastic sports day where the children all tried their best and had fun. Some clubs are run by external providers and some by staff. If you are interested in your child joining a club please contact the school office to see if there are spaces and what the charges are.

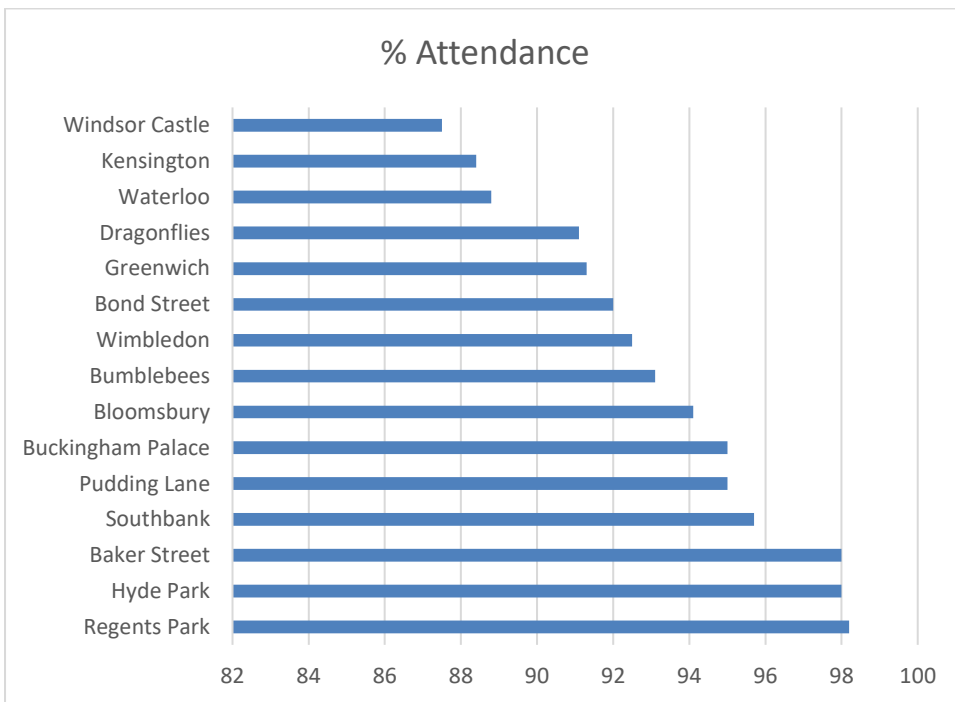

### Information from Kingston Grammar School

It would be greatly appreciated if you could pass along this information ahead of the booking opening on Friday.

#### KGS Open Day - Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023

The Open Day, taking place on Saturday, 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023, presents an excellent opportunity for families to explore our school site, interact with students and staff, and attend a presentation by the Head Master. Prospective families are invited to join the Head Master's presentation, followed by a guided tour led by one of our current students. Alternatively, they may opt for a guided tour without attending the presentation.

Guided tours will run every 30 minutes between 9.30am and 1.30pm, while the Head Master's presentations will take place from 10am to 1pm, followed by a guided tour. Please note that due to the popularity of our Open Day, bookings are necessary to attend the event. Each household can reserve a maximum of three tickets, and it is important they arrive within their allotted time slot.

#### 11+ Information Evening - Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023

The 11+ Information Evening, exclusively for parents of children in Year 6 at the time of the event, will be held on Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023. This presentation will focus on First Year entry to the School. During the evening, our Head Master, current students, and senior staff will cover a wide range of topics, including the admissions process, scholarships, wellbeing during the exams, and the induction process for successful candidates. At the end of the presentations, there will be a Q&A session with our Head Master, Stephen Lehec.

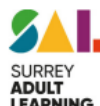
