Mathematics



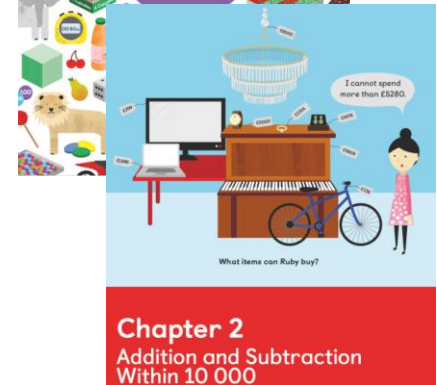
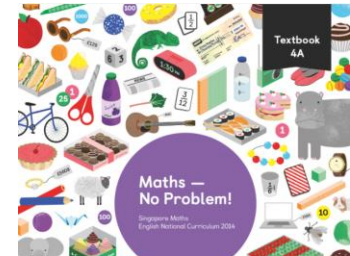

- ▶ National assessment across England in June
- ▶ Certain amount of time per question (6 seconds)
- ▶ Speed and accuracy
- ▶ Practice on Mathletics and Education City
- ▶ Y4 daily times tables practice in school

Yr 6 SATs



- ▶ National assessment across England
- ▶ Monday to Thursday May 13th to May 16th 2024
- ▶ Formal tests that are externally marked:
 - EGPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling)
 - Reading Comprehension
 - Maths paper 1, 2, 3 (arithmetic and reasoning)
- ▶ Teacher assessment for writing
- ▶ 100% attendance
- ▶ Results in July with reports



How to help your child

- ▶ Read with them and record in their diaries
- ▶ Encourage them
- ▶ Explore with them
- ▶ Encourage independence
- ▶ Engage them in conversations about their learning
- ▶ Look at mistakes as building resilience – we learn from mistakes
