# **Children in need**

Keep an eye out in your child's bag for their **sponsorship form for our Children in Need walking challenge** which is happening on the 17<sup>th</sup> November.

The children will be walking laps of the school field during the school day. (Are you able to offer some time to help stamp cards for the children as they go around?) They will be walking whatever the weather so please ensure they wear appropriate shoes and have a coat. The children can come to school wearing spots and it will be great to see them walking in their spots for such a worthy cause.

# **Forest school clothing**

Children going to forest school must wear long sleeves and a coat, especially when it is raining. If they do not have the correct clothing they will not be able to take part as we need to ensure they are warm, dry and safe. Thank you in advance for making sure they are properly equipped.

# Swimming

Living so near the river puts great emphasis on the need for all children to learn to swim and to become confident in the water.

"Inland water, such as rivers, canals, lakes, reservoirs, and quarries continue to be the leading locations for accidental drowning with 60% of deaths. "say the *Royal Lifesaving Society*.

This week there were a number of children who for a variety of reasons were not swimming. Swimming is a statutory part of the National Curriculum: pupils should be taught to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

We really want to encourage all children to take part in lessons so unless they are unwell, and in which case shouldn't be in school anyway, all members of the class that is swimming will be walking to the pool. Thank you for your understanding and for helping keep the children safe.

# **Secondary School Applications**

If your child is due to start secondary school in September 2024, you have until 31 October to apply for their school place.

If you miss the deadline, you reduce the chances of getting one of your preferred schools for your child. We recommend you apply as soon as possible and before schools break up for half term on 20 October, to avoid any last-minute hiccups.

<u>The online admissions system</u> is quick and easy to use. Here you will also find information about schools in your area.

You can apply using your mobile; surreycc.gov.uk/admissions

If you cannot apply online, you will need to call Surrey's Schools & Childcare Service on 0300 200 1004 to request a paper application form. Make sure you send it back to arrive no later than 31 October 2024. We recommend you send it by registered post. **Apply online; apply by 31 October.**


# **Online Learning**


Congratulations to our wonderful independent learners who have continued to improve their maths skills using mathletics. These results are for the start of this academic year and includes any online activities completed during the summer break.
