We made our way back to school after lunch. The children had such a good day they asked Mrs Coombs if they could do it all over again the next day (Mrs Coombs said no!!)!



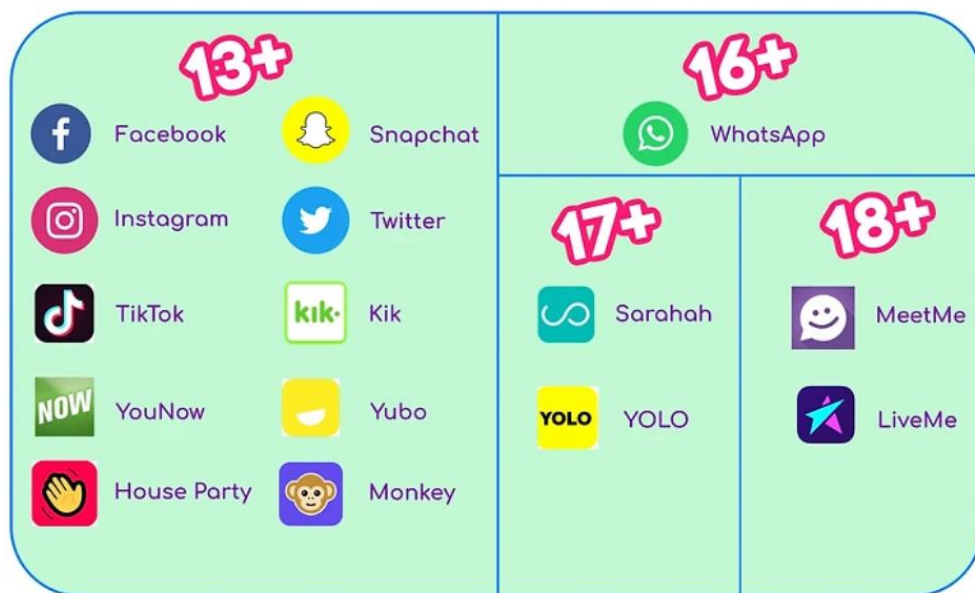
Online Learning

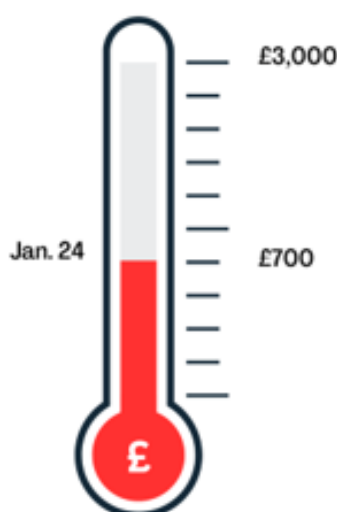
