Black trousers or shorts  
**Knitted** cardigan or jumper – navy

Plain black shorts  
Plain black jogging bottoms or leggings  
Plain black sweatshirt

Plain white/black non fashion trainers for outdoor games

White polo shirt

**Knitted** cardigan or jumper - navy

Sensible shoes (preferably without laces, and no open toes and no heels) or trainers
